

TRINITY AVENUE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

DURHAM, NC

Established in 1922, Trinity Avenue Presbyterian Church is located two blocks east of the Duke University Campus. To accommodate church growth, the church implemented a three-phase development plan. The first phase focused on site development, and included the piping of a small, open stream that bisected the property. With the completion of the first phase, a 13,500 square foot fellowship and education building was constructed along the eastern edge of the property. Completed in the architectural style of the historic sanctuary, the new facility completes the formal composition of the campus. To provide a more fitting public face for the complex, a new entry narthex was created as the third phase. Surmounted by a chapel, with commanding views of the surrounding neighborhood, the narthex links the sanctuary and administration areas and functions as the circulation hub of the newly connected facility.
