



HOME for TWO CHEFS CHAPEL HILL, NC

Designed for two nationally recognized chefs, this 4,700 square foot home is located on ten acres along Morgan Creek in Chapel Hill, NC. Sited to maximize views of the creek and the surrounding landscape, the home includes a study, wine cellar and substantial exterior entertaining areas. The Owners desired that the house be contemporary, while still being rooted in the rich vernacular history of the local area. To accomplish this, the design looked to the mill house prototype – an architectural form that is synonymous with the textile mill villages of North Carolina. The massing of the house references this traditional style. Expansive exterior porches serve to unify the design and to extend the living spaces.
